WHAT IS PARENT ORIENTATION? Parent orientation is a program designed to teach parents about children's developmental stages and how they impact parenting plans. Time is also spent discussing conflict resolution, effective methods to "co-parent," and Tehama County Superior Court's model for mediation, using a child custody recommending counselor (CCRC). Both parties should attend the class prior to participation in mediation. Parties may attend on separate days. There is no fee for this class. You will receive a Certificate of Completion after you have completed the class. Certificates are good for 2 years.

DO CHILDREN ATTEND ORIENTATION? Children should not attend orientation. This class is for the parents only. Unless requested otherwise, please **do not bring** the child(ren) to your appointment at Family Court Services.

WHAT IF I CAN'T COMPLETE THE PARENT ORIENTATION CLASS? If this occurs, It is important that you still appear at your mediation date, and at you Court hearing. However, you should be prepared to provide an explanation to the judge as to why you did not complete the parent orientation.

****NOTE: YOU WILL NEED TO BRING YOUR CASE NUMBER AND A PEN FOR FILLING OUT FORMS IN FAMILY COURT SERVICES.***
