LEGAL CUSTODY

1. **JOINT LEGAL CUSTODY** of the minor child(ren) shall be shared by both parents. In exercising joint legal custody, the parents shall share in the responsibility and confer in good faith on major decisions concerning the health, education and welfare of the minor children
2. **SOLE LEGAL CUSTODY** of the minor child(ren) shall be with _____.
3. Limited to emergency situations, each parent shall be authorized to take any and all actions necessary to protect the health and welfare of the child(ren), including, but not limited to consent to EMERGENCY surgical procedures or treatment. The parent authorizing such emergency treatment shall notify the other parent as soon as possible of such emergency situation and of all procedures or treatment administered to the child(ren).
4. Each parent shall notify the other of the name and address of each health practitioner who examines or treats the minor child(ren), such notifications to be made within **3** days of the commencement of the first such treatment or examination. Name, address and phone number shall be provided to the other parent prior to the first appointment.
5. Each parent shall keep the other advised at all times of his/her current residence/ mailing address, telephone/message numbers (home and work) the child(ren)'s school and the location of any place where the children will be spending any extended period of time of four days or more. Neither parent shall use such information for the purpose of harassing or annoying the other in any way, and each shall be specifically restrained and enjoined from disturbing the other's peace or invading the other's privacy by any means whatsoever.
6. Each parent shall have access to the child(ren)'s school, medical and dental records.
7. Each parent shall be designated as a person the child(ren)'s school is to contact in the event of an emergency; changes in schools shall be by written mutual agreement in advance if parents share legal custody.

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PHYSICAL CUSTODY

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EXCHANGE AND VISITATION PROVISIONS

RESTRAINTS ON CONDUCT

- 67. The parents shall communicate directly with each other in matters concerning the minor child(ren) and shall not use the child(ren) as messengers between them.
- 68. No one shall discuss custody and court related issues around the child unless directed to do so by the court.
- 69. Both parents shall not consume any narcotics or restricted dangerous drugs (except upon prescription) 24 hours prior to or during periods of time with the minor child(ren), nor allow any third person to do so in the presence of the minor child(ren).
- 70. _____ shall not use any alcohol ____ hours prior or during times with the minor child(ren).
- 71. The minor child(ren) shall not be exposed to second hand smoke while in the presence of either parent.
- 72. No party shall be intoxicated or under the influence of illegal substances while caretaking the minor child(ren).
- 73. Both parents are enjoined and restrained from inflicting corporal punishment or physical discipline of any kind on the minor child(ren), or permitting any third person to do so.
