**STANDING ORDER
2023-11**

Pursuant to California Vehicle Code 16373, the clerk of a court shall, subject to subdivision (b), issue upon the request of a judgment creditor a certified copy of any judgment or a certified copy of the register of actions in an action resulting in a judgment for damages, and a certificate of facts relative to the judgment on a form provided by the department.

Pursuant to California Vehicle Code 16379, when the court orders a payment of a judgment in installments, upon payment of the required fees, it shall forward a certified copy of the order to the Department of Motor Vehicles. The court shall determine the required fees.


Pursuant to California Vehicle Code 16381, when giving notice of the default to the Department of Motor Vehicles of the judgment debtor's default in making installment payments, the court shall determine the required fees.

THEREFORE, Pursuant to California Vehicle Codes 16373, 16379 and 16381, the required fee established for each code is \$40.00.

This standing order shall expire on December 31, 2023.
