ORDER

- A. Entry Requirements Effective May 9, 2022
 - Access to the courthouse is limited to individuals attesting that they are not currently sick,
 have not recently tested positive for COVID-19 and are within the isolation timeframes as
 outlined by the CDPH, and are not experiencing any COVID-19 symptoms as outlined by
 the CDPH. Any individual entering the courthouse must be in compliance with these
 conditions to gain entry. Any individual not in compliance shall call the Tehama Superior
 Court at (530) 527-3563.
 - 2. The Tehama County Sheriff and entrance screening staff may rely on individuals self-attesting their compliance and need not inquire of each individual entering the courthouse whether that individual is in compliance with the restriction on access. The Tehama County Sheriff may enforce the order when there is an objectively apparent need to do so inside the courthouse.

B. Masks Will Be Optional

Unless otherwise required by federal, state, or local public health mandate, individuals will no longer be required to wear a face covering while inside Tehama Superior Court facilities. Consistent with CDPH's strong recommendation that all persons, regardless of vaccination
